The Board of Directors of the Humboldt Community Services District met in Regular Session at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 24, 2021, via tele/video conference in accordance with the Governor's Executive Orders N-08-21.

A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Present upon roll call were Directors Bongio, Gardiner, Hansen, and Matteoli. Director Benzonelli arrived at 5:01 p.m. Staff in attendance: General Manager Williams (GM), Legal Counsel Plotz, Superintendent Latham, Finance Manager Montag (FM), and Assistant Engineer Adams (AE).

C. <u>REPORTS</u>

- 1. General Manager
 - a) General Status Report

GM reviewed his August 20, 2021 Memorandum summarizing:

- Drought and Conservation Messaging as mentioned at the last meeting, District customers have not responded well to the Governor's executive order in July requesting voluntary reduction in consumption by 15 per cent. GM presented a press release listing efficiency tips.
- Ridgewood Tank Status Work is proceeding ahead of schedule with anticipation of completion and the tank back on line as early as the second week of September.
- Capital Projects The AE, Superintendent, and GM are working diligently toward execution and completion of the current fiscal year's aggressive Capital Improvement Program.

- 2. Engineering
 - a) AE summarized his August 19, 2021 Memorandum addressing various activities of the department. Upon request for elaboration upon the Water Model, AE advised he is still identifying some intricacies such as missing details, but overall, it is working fine. GM added that the creators of the model have agreed to free of charge clarification when needed.
- 3. Superintendent
 - a) July Operations/Maintenance Department Report

Superintendent reviewed his August 19, 2021 Memorandum elaborating upon activities over and beyond those anticipated during a standard month: testing of all stationary/portable generators, annual cathodic protection inspection/maintenance for all water storage tanks, responding to a power outage.

- 4. Finance Department
 - a) July 2021 Budget Statement

FM reviewed the report without question adding that the State Water Board's Arrearages Survey is nearing completion which is the first step in receiving a distribution of the \$985 Million relief funding of unpaid customer bills during COVID.

6. Director Reports

Director Benzonelli – Reported her attendance at the monthly RREDC meeting wherein HBMWD advised they are still pressuring the Department of Toxic Substance Control regarding the toxic plume in Blue Lake and they continue to look for available options to maintain the majority of their 65 MGD allotment when the agreement comes up for renewal in five-years. Redway CSD reported they are completely out of water, and there was a presentation about the roll-out plans for converting HSU to a polytechnic school.

The similar skills and credentials required for each level (I, II, III) have been streamlined into three proposed job descriptions, rather than the existing nine, which will provide seamless lateral transfers between departments.



Subject:	2022 Employee/Retiree Health Benefits Renewal Update

Every year around this time, the ACWA/JPIA update their benefits packages in preparation for the upcoming open enrollment. This year is no different. There are minor cost changes to the HMO and PPO plans, there are new mental health benefits, some minor changes to dental and vision benefits and Medicare retiree benefits are transitioning to the United Healthcare Medicare PPO. The following paragraphs provide details on each of these changes.

Fiscal Year 21/22 rates are significantly lower than the projected budget expenses of 14%. Anthem PPO plans will realize a 5% *decrease*, while HMO's will only incur a 2.2% increase. There will be no change to the life, short- & long-term disability, dental or vision premiums.

The open enrollment period for plan changes to take effect on January 1, 2022 begins October 4 and ends October 29, 2021. Open enrollment is the one time a year that an employee/director can add dependents, change medical plans, opt out of coverage (with proof of other coverage) etc., outside of a 30-day grace period for a life event (i.e., marriage, birth/adoption).

Effective September 1, 2021, Modern Health Mental Health Benefits became available to all employees, directors and their dependents. Please see the attached flyer. Modern Health's network is enhanced by partnering with coaches in addition to therapists. Patients are triaged through a self-assessment tool with an average time to connect with a provider of 1.8 days. Services are available by video, chat, and in person. This additional benefit to employees and their dependents will not increase rates billed to the District or other JPIA members. A webinar targeted toward employees was held September 8, 2021 for those interested to learn about the benefit. The session was recorded for later review.

Effective January 1, 2022, the following enhancements will be implemented by ACWA/JPIA:

1. Delta Dental PPO will cover 100% of preventive and diagnostic services.

- 2. Vision Plus
 - contact lens allowance will increase from \$120 to \$150
 - anti-reflective coating for \$25 copay. This was not a previously covered benefit.

Medicare Retirees

Beginning January 1, 2022, all retirees with Medicare will transition to enrollment in the United Healthcare (UHC) Medicare Advantage PPO. Premiums average 29% less than current premiums for Medicare eligible retirees. Prescription copays will not change, but virtually all deductibles will be non-existent to the retiree. Another improvement is there will only be one ID card necessary that will cover Medicare, health, and prescriptions. As the plan rolls out, more details will be released by the JPIA.

According to ACWA/JPIA, 99.85% of doctors accept UHC Medicare Advantage, so the transition should be seamless to the retiree merely requiring doctor office paperwork/billing updates. Additional benefits include a no cost gym membership at 12,000+ locations, online brain health programs, local wellness events, etc.


HCSD staff participated in an August 25 webinar to receive information about timelines, what to expect, and how to assist retirees with questions. ACWA/JPIA mailed the UHC plan announcement to retirees with Medicare on September 7, and have set up an "800" call center as well as scheduled webinars on each Wednesday in October to assist retirees with the change and to answer questions they may have.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board review and consider approving the attached letter from District Counsel, disclosing a conflict of interest with the City of Eureka and requesting the Board's consent to exclusively represent the District concerning the District's existing contracts with the City, while continuing to represent the City in unrelated Code Enforcement matters. Approval by roll call vote.

Summary:

The District's Legal Counsel, Ryan Plotz, is a member of The Mitchell Law Firm, LLP. The Mitchell Law Firm has historically represented the City in the defense of civil rights and police practices matters and currently represents the City in the prosecution of certain misdemeanor Code violations. The Mitchell Law Firm has not provided any advice or counsel to the City regarding the wastewater treatment plant or any agreements between the City and the District. The Mitchell Law Firm did represent a local contractor in the litigation arising from the Martin Slough interceptor project.

In order for the District's Legal Counsel to advise the District in matters related to the performance of contracts between the District and the City, an acknowledgement of the conflict with The Mitchell Law Firm would need to be signed by the District's Board of Directors and the City Council (Draft Conflict Waiver included in this packet). This waiver does not authorize The Mitchell Law Firm to bring litigation against the City arising from either parties' performance without obtaining further conflict waiver.

Staff would like the ability to be advised by the District's General Legal Counsel regarding contract performance items because of the general rapport, convenience, and Counsel's understanding of the relationships.

Staff is also working to obtain and evaluate a collection of proposals from a select group of legal firms to represent the District in the renegotiation of the Water Purchase Agreement and the Wastewater Treatment Agreement. Re: Disclosure of Conflict of Interest; Request for Mutual Waiver Humboldt CSD – City of Eureka

Dear Mayor Seaman, President Bongio, Councilmembers and Directors:

This letter requests the consent of the City of Eureka ("City") and the Humboldt Community Services District ("HCSD") to The Mitchell Law Firm, LLP's ("Law Firm"), exclusive representation of HCSD in connection with providing legal advice and counsel regarding existing contractual agreement between the City and HCSD relating to the joint use of the Elk River Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP") and existing water purchase agreement, while continuing to represent the City in unrelated matters.

Existing Relationships

Both HCSD and the City are existing clients and valued of the Law Firm. Law Firm, principally through attorney Ryan Plotz, serves as District Counsel for HCSD, providing advice and counsel on a wide variety of subjects.

Law Firm, principally through attorney Ryan Plotz and Edwin Aguilar, represents the City in prosecuting violations of the Eureka Municipal Code in the Humboldt Superior Court and other Code Enforcement matters under the direction of the City Attorney.

Existing Contractual Agreements

HCSD is a contracting partner with the City through which the District has rights to 32.1 percent of the treatment capacity of the WWTP and, in turn, the District's rate payers pay for 32.1 percent of the operations, maintenance and capital improvements to the shared facility. HCSD also purchases from the City a portion of its water supply under a separate contract.

By way of this letter, Law Firm is requesting the mutual consent of the City Council and the HCSD Board of Directors to Law Firm's exclusive representation of HCSD in matters relating to contract interpretation and performance of the existing agreements. It is my understanding that the City Attorney's Office provides advice and counsel to the City concerning the existing agreements with HCSD.

If approved, the consent would not extend to (i) any litigation that may arise in the future between HCSD and the City concerning or arising from the existing agreements or (ii) the direct negotiation between HCSD and the City concerning new or revised agreements for the shared use of the WWTP or water purchase. If either event arose in the future, we would assist HCSD in finding alternative counsel or request your further consent.

If disapproved by either entity, Law Firm will declare a conflict and assist HCSD to obtaining alternative counsel.

Potential Conflicts of Interest

Our Law Firm's representation of HCSD regarding the existing agreements with the City creates a conflict of interest relating to our representation of the City because the interests of HCSD and the City are not identical and may, in certain aspects, conflict with September 8, 2021 Page: 3

one another. Our exclusive representation of HCSD in this matter requires that we represent HCSD's interests vigorously, even if HCSD's interests do not align with the City's interests. Providing your mutual consent to this letter authorizes Law Firm to exclusively represent HCSD regarding matters of contract interpretation and performance of the existing agreements with the City without regard to what may be in the best interest of the City.

Providing your mutual consent does not, however, obviate our obligation to maintain client confidences or otherwise permit us to disclose any confidential information obtained from the City to HCSD. At this time, we believe that we can exclusively represent HCSD as to the existing agreements and still maintain our duty of loyalty and confidentiality to the City in all unrelated matters in which we represent the City. We do not believe we have obtained any confidential information from the City which is material to our representation of HCSD. Further, we do not believe we have obtained any confidential information from the City in unrelated matters.

Nevertheless, if additional facts come to our attention which lead us to believe that: (i) we could not maintain our duty of loyalty and confidentiality to the City or HCSD, (ii) the issue in dispute is substantially related to the same issue in an unrelated matter in which we represent the City; or (iii) we have obtained confidential information from HCSD, which is material to our representation of the City in unrelated matters, we would require further written consent from HCSD and the City before we could continue to represent HCSD in matters concerning the existing agreements.

Rule 1.7 of the California Rules of Professional Conduct provides in pertinent part:

(a) A lawyer shall not, without informed written consent from each client and compliance with paragraph (d), represent a client if the representation is directly adverse to another client in the same or a separate matter.

(b) A lawyer shall not, without informed written consent from each affected client and compliance with paragraph (d), represent a client if there is a significant risk the lawyer's representation of the client will be materially limited by the lawyer's responsibilities to or relationships with another client, a former client or a third person, or by the lawyer's own interests.

(c) Even when a significant risk requiring a lawyer to comply with paragraph (b) is not present, a lawyer shall not represent a client without written disclosure of the relationship to the client and compliance with paragraph (d) where:

(1) the lawyer has, or knows that another lawyer in the lawyer's firm has, a legal, business, financial, professional, or personal relationship with or responsibility to a party or witness in the same matter; or

(2) the lawyer knows or reasonably should know that another party's lawyer is a spouse, parent, child, or sibling of the lawyer, lives with the lawyer, is a client of the lawyer or another lawyer in the lawyer's firm, or has an intimate personal relationship with the lawyer.

(d) Representation is permitted under this rule only if the lawyer complies with paragraphs (a), (b), and (c), and:

(1) the lawyer reasonably believes that the lawyer will be able to provide competent and diligent representation to each affected client;

(2) the representation is not prohibited by law; and

(3) the representation does not involve the assertion of a claim by one client against another client represented by the lawyer in the same litigation or other proceeding before a tribunal.

(e) For purposes of this rule, "matter" includes any judicial or other proceeding, application, request for a ruling or other determination, contract, transaction, claim, controversy, investigation, charge, accusation, arrest, or other deliberation, decision, or action that is focused on the interests of specific persons, or a discrete and identifiable class of persons.

In accord with the foregoing, written consent to the exclusive representation of HCSD in matters concerning the existing agreement with the City and concurrent representation of HCSD and the City in unrelated matters is hereby requested.

Consent

As attorneys where we have a relationship with multiple parties a conflict of interest must be disclosed and informed written consent obtained from both parties. Accordingly, we are seeking the informed written consent of the City Council and the Board of Directors before exclusively representing HCSD in matters concerning the existing agreements concerning the WWTP and water purchase.

Request

If, after considering the foregoing, the Council and Board are each willing to consent, please sign and return to us the enclosed copy of this letter (i) acknowledging that we have informed you of our existing relationship with the City and HCSD; (ii) acknowledging that HCSD and the City have been advised of the conflict of interest associated with our exclusively representing HCSD in matters concerning the existing contracts while continuing to represent the City in wholly unrelated matters; and (iii) indicating that you consent to our representation as described in this letter.

If either the City or HCSD is not willing to consent, we will declare a conflict and assist HCSD in locating alternate counsel for issues related to any direct agreements between your two entities.
